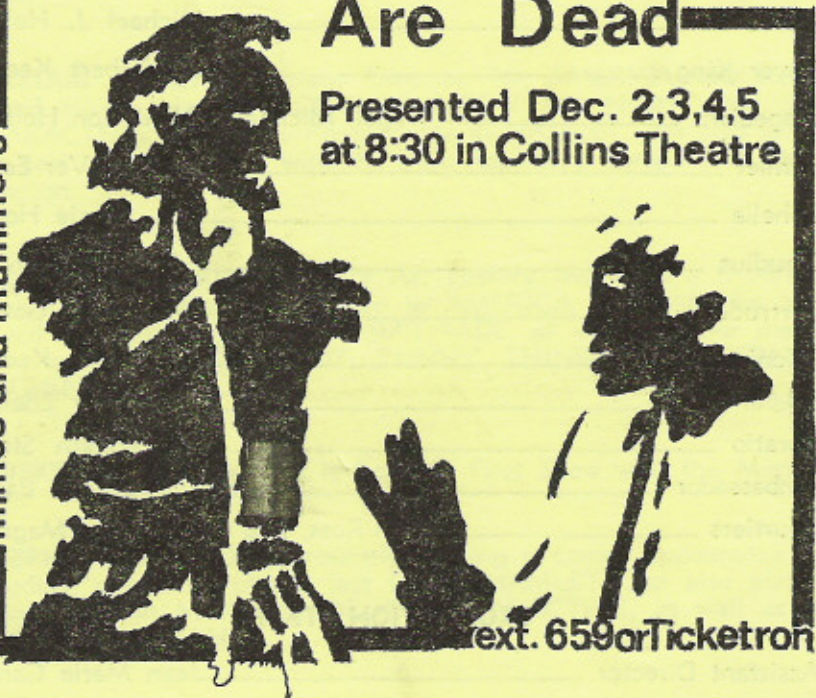

WHO'S WHO IN THE CAST AND CREW

CHARLES STAHL, Last seen as Cucurucu in *MARAT/SADE*, Charlie will also be remembered as The Boy of *SIX CHARACTERS*, as well as having acted in *INFERNAL MACHINE* and *BAREFOOT IN THE PARK*.

WILLIAM REILLY, Assistant Director for *AMERICA HURRAH*, played major roles in *MORNING, NOON* and *NIGHT* and *SIX CHARACTERS*, as well as Rosencrantz in *HAMLET*. Bill also spent this past summer acting with the Yale Repertory Company in East-hampton.

MICHAEL O'ROURKE, a senior Art History Major, is a ten-show veteran of the Mimes. Last seen in *AMERICA HURRAH*, he also played the role of Sade in *MARAT/SADE*, as well as other major roles in *NOON, BAREFOOT, FUNNY THING* and *INFERNAL MACHINE*.

ROBERT VER ECKE, This is Robert's First Show with the Mimes.

JOSEPH LOSCHIAVO is presently making a cameo appearance as Claudius, a role he played last fall in *HAMLET*. Joe also played major roles in *MARAT/SADE, SIX CHARACTERS*, as well as in *AMERICA HURRAH*.

JAMES KEENAN makes his second appearance on the Fordham stage. Previously, he appeared as Duperret in *MARAT/SADE*.

JEAN MARIE GARRETT is a student at Bensalem College. She feels no more need be said.

DAN WILCOX is a veteran Mimes Director of the past two years. He directed both *SIX CHARACTERS* and *THE HOMECOMING*. This past June, Dan was awarded an Emmy as one of the writers for *SESAME STREET*.

GERALD KARR, a junior Fine Arts major, has had major production roles in every Mimes show of the past three years as well as serving on the Executive Board for the past two years.
